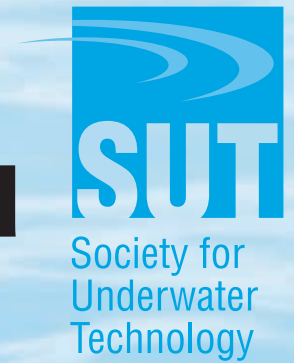


# Oceans of Opportunity

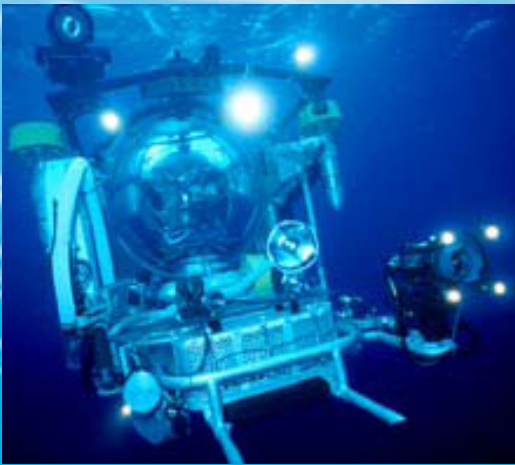
## The Underwater World of Science and Technology
